Hyde Park One of London's largest and most famous royal parks, Hyde Park offers a peaceful green space in the heart of the city.

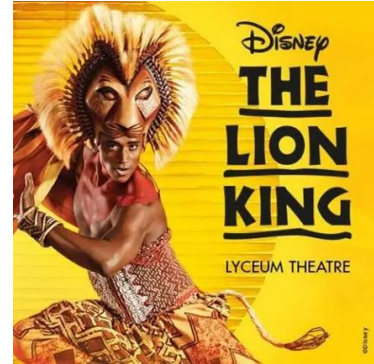
Natural History Museum Renowned for its impressive exhibitions, the Natural History Museum showcases the natural world, including dinosaurs, fossils, and scientific discoveries.
